Kangaroo Valley Horses is located in the BUDGONG and MORTON National Parks on dirt roads. **Please print the directions below to avoid getting lost as GPS is not reliable for this location.**

Please note that Mobile Phone coverage is extremely limited and access can be difficult for cars set very low to the ground in rainy weather on Abernethys dirt road. Please phone in advance if concerned about access.

Weight Restriction

Maximum weight per rider is 90kilos.

Height of Riders

For suitable horse allocation please advise if riders are over 6 foot tall - (183cm)

What to wear

Comfortable long trousers or jodhpurs, a long sleeve sun protective shirt and enclosed shoes with a low heel or riding boots. Australian Approved AS3838 Riding Helmets are provided.

What to bring

Water bottle, sunscreen, raincoat

Weather

For safety reasons rides and lessons will be cancelled or postponed in heavy rain and thunderstorms and in very high winds. Horse rides go ahead in light rain showers. Please phone 0402 902 072 on the day if in doubt.

Princes Highway to Kangaroo Valley Horses on “Riverstone”

1. Follow the Princes highway driving south past Wollongong, Kiama, Berry, Meroo Meadow and Bomaderry.
 2. At Bomaderry continuing south along the Princes Highway, drive past Abernethy’s lane. The address is Abernethy’s Road.
 3. Continue on the Princes highway until immediately BEFORE the bridge over the Shoalhaven River. Turn right onto Illaroo road – **do not cross over the bridge**.
 4. Continue straight ahead along Illaroo Road (Take the 2nd exit at the round about) until Illaroo road turns off to the left. At this point drive straight ahead following the signs to Kangaroo Valley on Budgong Road. **Don’t follow Illaroo road when it turns left to Bundanon!**
 5. Continue along Budgong road for approx 6 km (you will pass Lyrebird Ridge Winery on your right and Lower Budgong Road on your left at the Budgong National Park)
 6. Turn left into Abernethys Road approx 50m after Foxwood Park. Abernethy’s Road is a bumpy road which runs through the Budgong National Park for 2.5 km. Wind your way down the valley to the Riverstone gate. Please remember to shut the gate.
- For Trail Rides, Camps & Lessons - Turn left through the first gate on the left to the stables (at the cattle yards following the olive grove). Welcome!

Causeway Crossing - Please do not take this route after very heavy rain!

1. If you are driving South to the Kangaroo Valley along the M5. Exit at the Mittagong exit
2. Take the left fork in Mittagong and drive through to Bowral
3. Follow signs to Nowra and the Kangaroo Valley (Sheepwash Road)
4. After driving down the mountain to the base, turn right into Mount Scanzi Road shortly after the Hampden Bridge before you reach the Kangaroo Valley shops.
5. Approx. 500metres past the golf course turn left at the Budgong sign following the Mount Scanzi (Gravel) road. **(Be careful not to drive straight ahead to Tallawa Dam)**
6. Wind your way up the hill on mostly gravel road to the crest. At the top drive straight ahead onto Budgong Road.
7. Wind your way down the hill for 2 km until you reach the “Duffy’s Corner” T junction.
8. Turn LEFT at Duffy’s corner following the sign to Nowra on Bugong Road
9. Follow Bugong Road for 2 km and drive across the wooden School Creek Bridge.
10. Drive across the causeway crossing **(This crossing can be dangerous after very heavy rain!)** Cross the causeway and drive up the hill beneath the rocky overhang.
11. Drive past Selby’s road (on your left) continuing straight ahead for a further 3km along Bugong Road.
12. Abernethys Road is on your right at the top of a small rise.
13. Abernethy’s Road is a bumpy dirt road winding down the hill through the Budgong National Park for 2.5 km to the Kangaroo Valley Horses “Riverstone” gate.
14. Please remember to shut the gate. For Trail Rides, Camps, Lessons & Clinics - Turn left through the first gate on the left to the stables (at the cattle yards following the olive grove). Welcome!
